MONTOUR COUNTY NEEDS YOUR HELP! PLEASE VOLUNTEER TODAY!

The Montour County Emergency Management Agency has been tasked with implementing a plan to save lives if faced with a catastrophic infectious disease or bioterrorism event. As part of a state mandate in emergency preparedness, a POD Site (Point of Dispensing), has been selected in the County. The POD is a community-based site that will be set up to medicate up to 20,000 people within 48 hours. To accomplish this many volunteers will be needed. Our plan is to staff 50 positions in 12 hour shifts with each position having 3 individuals trained.

Volunteers from all walks of life, medical and non-medical, are needed to become trained now! No experience necessary; anyone 18 years or older, with no felony convictions, who has the ability to work a 12-hour shift, is asked to register. All volunteers will receive free training and be guided through a Disaster Preparedness Exercise this Fall.

Should the POD Site be activated, you become a first responder, which means that you and your family will get meds FIRST. The time commitment is minimal while the number of lives saved is great. This is not a one person endeavor, but rather a concert of community participation for the health and well being of our citizens in case of a catastrophic event.

We are seeking Medically Trained Professionals to dispense medications and to function as Clinicians, Trained Dispensers, Medical Screeners/Evaluators and Triage & Treatment Personnel.

VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS & RESPONSIBILITIES

As a Montour County Volunteer applicant, I understand that the purpose of this application is to enable Montour County to build a database of potential volunteers for call down in case of a public health emergency. That, in case of my deployment for a countywide public health emergency, I may be contacted at anytime, day or night. That I am at least 18 years of age and hold a current valid Pennsylvania Drivers License. That due to the nature and content of the Strategic National Stockpile and Mass Vaccination Plans and the potential duties of volunteers, a background check of my educational background, professional licenses, police records, employment and/or volunteer history may be conducted on volunteer applicants. I understand a felony conviction for DUI, drug-related, sexual or family violence offences may disqualify me for participation as a volunteer in the SNS Program. That all information regarding the Strategic National Stockpile and Mass Vaccination Plans are considered confidential and I will not release names, locations of warehouses or any other sensitive information without permission of the SNS or County Program Coordinator. That any information I have provided in this application may be used by, and disclosed to, the Regional SNS Coordinator or County Program Coordinator for planning purposes and volunteer assignment only.
